The Presidential Center Stevo Pendarovski is proud to announce the open call for the first cohort of the "Echoes of Democracy" political school. This 3-month program is designed to empower the next generation of leaders from the Western Balkans with the tools, knowledge, and networks needed to navigate and influence our region's evolving democratic landscape.

About the Project

The "Echoes of Democracy: Western Balkan Political Messages and the Path Forward - A School for Young Professionals" is an innovative 12-month project designed to foster democratic resilience and regional cooperation among young professionals from the Western Balkans. This project is funded by the Open Society Foundations - Western Balkans and supported by the Friedrich Ebert Foundation (Skopje) in association with the Zoran Djindjic Foundation.

About the Program

"Echoes of Democracy" offers a unique educational journey through three intensive modules. Participants will explore themes such as EU integration, civic activism, and cultural politics, and use them to analyze how historical and contemporary discourse shapes democratic trajectories. By bridging the gap between academic theory and practical advocacy, the initiative empowers emerging leaders to navigate complex political landscapes.

A central and innovative feature of the school is the "Digital Museum of Political Messages and Rhetoric"—a living archive of slogans, banners, and public rhetoric from Western Balkan elections and protests. Participants will use this platform to analyze the progress and regress of democratic development in the region.

- **Advocacy & Networking:** In-module workshops on advocacy skills and two public round tables to engage with experts and civil society.
